Report

Our students wrote history by accomplishing a feat which is achieved rarely. Students of class XII appeared for the examination in 2017-18, out of which 12 students scored A1 grade (i.e. above 90%), 5 students appeared for compartment. And the pass percentage was 96.4% which is much higher than the previous years. The Excellence Index in 2017 was 70.89 and in 2018 it rose to 80.3 with an increase of almost 10 percent & the Quality Index reached 7 in 2018 from 6.73 of 2017.
